Mission at heart of upcoming Provincial Council meeting

When members of the Ecclesiastical Province of Canada's Provincial Council gather together in September, God's mission will be the framework for their deliberations.

Following up on General Synod's focus on the Anglican Communion's Five Marks of Mission, a series of reflections on mission will be offered to the members of Provincial Council by Ellie Johnson, the recently retired Director of Partnerships for the Anglican Church of Canada.

Still with mission as its focus, Provincial Council will also continue its discussion around issues of governance. In doing so, it will take up General Synod's invitation to carry on the conversation about "whether and how the diocesan, provincial and national structures need to be modified to support and enhance mission."

The Provincial Council will meet September 23-26, 2010, in Cavendish, Prince Edward Island. The Council's 31 members represent the seven Anglican dioceses which make up the Ecclesiastical Province of Canada: Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island, Quebec, Fredericton, Montreal, Eastern Newfoundland and Labrador, Central Newfoundland, and Western Newfoundland.
