## **Diocesan Assessments Since 2016**

For the triennium 2025-2027, the Executive committee is proposing a budget that reflects an assessment "holiday". That is, as in-person meetings of the Synod and its Council are unlikely, we are proposing a budget that would cover the ordinary expenses of the Province out of an existing financial reserve established to meet the cost of hypothetical in-person meetings. What follows is a document prepared in 2023 that gives some history of assessments in the Province from 2016 onwards.

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In 2015 Synod approved Assessments totalling <u>\$55,000</u> per year for the 2016-18 Triennium.

2018 Synod gave responsibility for Ministry to the Dioceses, thus removing \$54,000 from the proposed budget for 2019-21.

Assessments for the 2019-21 Triennium were reduced to \$38,000 per year.

2018 Synod also said (<u>Motion 14</u>) if no in-person Synod was planned for 2021, then the unspent part of the \$60,000 budgeted for an in-person Synod was to be refunded to the Dioceses "in proportion to their contributions".

Then-Treasurer Peter Irish calculated \$40,447 as the refundable amount, including arrears. Peter Irish and Mark Kingsbury proposed to the 2021 Synod (<u>Motion 10</u>) that this amount be retained and that Diocesan assessments be cancelled for the 2022-24 triennium. This motion was <u>defeated</u>. Later in 2021, \$53,184 was reimbursed to Dioceses, with arrears paid off.

Assessments for the 2022-24 Triennium were then set at <u>\$9255</u> per year.

The Diocesan Assessments, plus \$1500 in Investment Income, are our only budgeted revenue sources. They cover the following annual budgeted expenses:

Nothing was included in the 2021-2024 budget for Synod, Provincial Council, or Executive inperson meetings. nor for Elections, Consecrations, and Installations. Formerly, these had added about \$29,000 to expenses.
