This letter comes with best wishes from your Executive as we prepare for the Provincial Synod of the Ecclesiastical Province of Canada. Provincial Synod will meet in Halifax in the Diocese of Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island from Friday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, to Sunday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Synod begins with registration on Friday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, at 1:30 pm, and finishes with the closing Eucharist followed by lunch around 2:00 pm.

If you will not be attending Provincial Synod, please contact your Diocesan Synod Office immediately so that they can notify your alternate to allow them to register and make travel arrangements in your place.

#### **Location**

Synod will take place at the University of King's College, Halifax, with accommodations in single rooms and meals provided on site. If a spouse or partner will be attending the synod with you, please register them when you register yourself. You will be provided a double room. You will be expected to pay an additional expense of \$25 per night, plus their meals. The billing for these expenses will be handled at Synod,

#### Travel:

For those of you who will be travelling by air, please make your arrangements as soon as possible to help ensure you get the lowest airfare.

If you travelling with your spouse or partner, please include them when booking through Cynthia. Delegates should arrive at the Halifax Airport by no later than 12:00 noon on Friday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, and plan to depart no earlier than 4:00 pm on Sunday, June 10<sup>th</sup>.

If you are driving to Halifax, please keep an accurate record of your mileage for reimbursement by the Provincial Synod. Mileage will be paid at the rate of 53 cents/km. Meals on route are also payable at the Provincial Rate. (See the Provincial Expense Claim form and Expense Policy on our website.) Mileage,

meals, and miscellaneous expenses en route will be paid up to the cost of a return economy airfare ticket from your nearest airport.

It is your responsibility to download all reports and read them before Synod. If you do not have internet access and wish to receive a paper copy of the reports and notices of motion, please notify the secretaries as soon as possible. Paper copies will not be available at Synod, except for those who have requested them in advance.
- 3. We are endeavouring to be environmentally friendly and so we ask you to bring your laptops, tablet, iPad, etc., to Synod to view documents electronically. All information during Synod will be posted to the Provincial Synod.
- 4. All members of Synod are expected to attend the entire Synod.
- 5. Notices of Motion should be submitted, in writing, by <u>May  $10^{th}$  to the Secretaries</u>.
- 6. Also, part of Synod will be the election of a new Executive and Council. Position descriptions for all the provincial officers are posted on the website. We encourage you to review the positions and think about nominations.
