

Report on the election of the Metropolitan

The election of the new metropolitan was done using the electronic voting system Simply Voting. All diocesan bishops were automatically on the ballot and our canons require that to be elected the candidate must receive 50% of the votes in each of the three houses of Bishops, Clergy and Lay. The Rt. Rev. Percy David Coffin was elected on the second ballot with 79.4 % of the votes cast.
